



Roy Calvin Geist

July 7, 1935 - February 29, 2012

Roy C. Geist of Trappe, MD, died on Wednesday, February 29, 2012, at Easton Memorial Hospital. He was 76 years young. Born on July 7, 1935 in Philadelphia, PA, he was the son of the late Claude Calvin Geist and Viola Wittmeyer Geist.

Mr. Geist proudly served in the US Army for three years, including 14 months in Korea.

He is survived by his four children, R.
