Roy E. Riggin died Tuesday, August 5, 2003 at Anne Arundel Medical Center. He was 80 years old.

Born in Baltimore, July 7, 1923, he was the son of the late Roy and Frances Riggin. He was a 1940 graduate of Crisfield High School and during WWII served in the United States Navy as radioman 2nd Class on the USS LST from 1941-1945.
