Roy C. Wagner of Easton, MD passed away on Monday, February 20, 2006 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. He was 84.

Born April 9, 1921 in York, PA, he was the son of the late Charles F. and Daisy Brodbeck Wagner. He attended public school in Shrewsbury, PA and received his GED. During World War II he served in the U.S. Army. Following his release from active duty in 1948 he began a life-long career as a meat cutter and worked for Chesapeake Frozen Foods and then Startt Brothers Market where he remained until his retirement in 1988.

He was a member of Sts. Peter & Paul Catholic Church, a life member of Regina Coeli Council Knights of Columbus, a charter member of Father Mosley Assembly 4th Degree Knights of Columbus, and since 1988 was a member of the Memorial Hospital Auxiliary.

Mr. Wagner is survived by his wife, the former Margaret Dulin, whom he married September 11, 1943; two daughters, Delores W. Tarpley of Sharptown, MD and Viola Lokey of Princess Anne, MD; two grandchildren; four step-grandchildren and five step-great-grandchildren. He was predeceased by a brother, Russell Wagner.
