



## Royce Peabody

June 8, 1925 - June 3, 2016

Royce A. Peabody passed away peacefully at his home in Londonderry on June 3, 2016, surrounded by his family. He was born in Brooklyn, NY, on June 8, 1925.

He summered at Lake Hopatcong, NJ, where he acquired a lifelong passion for sailing at the Lake Hopatcong Yacht Club. Royce captained boats from 14 to 54 feet and was equally expert at handling them all.

Upon graduation from Brooklyn's Colby Academy in just three years, Royce went on to Colgate University from which he also graduated in three years with a degree in chemistry. While in the north country, he became an avid skier. After graduation, Royce moved to Montclair, NJ, and began a successful career in sales. He joined the Montclair Ski Club and became a member of the National Ski Patrol at Mad River Glen.

Royce married Elinore Stahlin in 1971, and they spent several happy years in Mendham, NJ. In 1978, the call of the sea brought Royce to Annapolis. He left his position with Kidder Peabody to become manager of the local Legg Mason office. After a few years, Royce and Ellie moved to several homes in Oxford and Easton. He continued as a broker and vice-president of sales in the Easton Office of Legg Mason. Royce was a member of the Tred Avon Yacht Club, where he joined the race committee and was a Board Member of the

Oxford Community Center.

In addition to summer sailing on the Chesapeake, Royce and Ellie sailed extensively in the Caribbean and Mediterranean as well as on Long Island Sound. They also enjoyed traveling to Europe, Alaska, and the Pacific Northwest.

Royce is survived by his daughter, Christine Caro and her husband Ken of Williamsburg, VA; as well as his dear friend, Bettie Baer of Easton, MD. He was preceded in death by his parents, Lewis and Lillian Stickle Peabody, and his wife, Elinore.
