Roy Paul Whitby of Queenstown, MD died at the Memorial Hospital, Easton on Wednesday, December 14, 2005. He was 86.

Born June 28, 1919 in Piney Neck, Queenstown, MD, he was the son of the late Walter Lee and Sallie Mae Jones Whitby. On September 8, 1951 he married the former, Mary Imelda Clark. He was a farmer and waterman for the majority of his life and enjoyed flying small airplanes.
