Ruby Zell Bryant passed away on September 25, 2016 at Envoy of Denton in Denton, MD. She was 93.

Born on December 27, 1922 in Buchanan, Virginia, to the late John and Dovie Smith Manspile. She grew up, one of eleven children, on a farm in Buchanan, VA and graduated from Buchanan High School. She moved to Newport News, VA to work at the Ship Yard Commissary Store. She then met and married Robert Bryant and they continued to live in Newport News until moving to Brooklyn Park, MD and later to Texas in 1978. Mrs. Bryant was a homemaker and an Avon Sales Consultant. She and her husband later owned and operated the South Lake Wood Bait & Grocery in Texas, a bait and tackle shop, grocery store and gas station. Mr. Bryant predeceased her in 1998. She moved to the Eastern Shore of Maryland in 2000, living in Centreville to be with her family. Mrs. Bryant became a member of the Methodist Church while living in Texas.
