



Ruby McCall Young

February 17, 1919 - February 18, 2014

Ruby McCall Young died Tuesday, February 18 at the Corsica Hills Nursing Center in Centreville, MD. She was 95.

She was born on February 17, 1919, in Carroll Co., MO, where her great-great-grandfather, Captain William McCall, had acquired land after the War of 1812 in the Missouri Territory before Missouri became a state. The daughter of the late James Edward McCall and Jessie Braden McCall, she was a graduate of Carrollton High School in Carrollton, MO. She married Herbert Hadley Young in 1939. He preceded her in death in 1992.

The Youngs established an antiques business which became nationally known and was listed among the country's top 50 antiques shops. Joined by their son, Gary E. Young, in the mid-1970s, the business specialized in 18th century English and Irish furniture and exhibited at the major antiques shows including the Winter Antiques Show in New York City, the Philadelphia University Hospital Antiques Show, and the Washington Antiques Show. In 1983, they moved the business from Lexington, MO, to Centreville, MD on the Eastern Shore. After their son's retirement, the business closed in 2009.

Mrs. Young was a member of the Daughters of the American Revolution for over 50 years. She was a member of St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Centreville, MD.

She is survived by her son, Gary E. Young, of Centreville, MD, and Washington, DC, and a large number of nieces and nephews who live in Missouri, Texas and Virginia.

A memorial service will be held at the graveside at Old Wye Episcopal Church, Wye Mills, MD, on Thursday, May 1 at 11 a.m.
