



Rudolf Schlesner

November 3, 1937 - June 16, 2008

Rudolf Schlesner died Monday, June 16, 2008 at his home. He was 70 years old.

Born on November 3, 1937 in Lagny, France, he was the son of the late Rudolf Schlesner and Martha Tepper. He was educated in Germany where he did his apprenticeship in brick masonry. In May 1960 he would immigrate to the USA and settle in Maryland where he began serving in the United States Army until 1967. In 1963, he married Ilse I. Reiser and in 1983 they moved to Stevensville, MD. He worked for F & S Construction in Baltimore and Baltimore Masonry as a foreman before retiring in 2000. Mr. Schlesner worked on several large construction projects including Memorial Stadium, Camden Yards, M & T Stadium, and various other projects in the Baltimore and Washington areas. He was a member of the Local #1 Bricklayers of Virginia, Maryland, and Washington, D.C.

He enjoyed crabbing and fishing.

Mr. Schlesner is survived by his wife, Ilse (Reiser) Schlesner of Stevensville, MD; 2 sons, Rudolf Schlesner, Jr and his wife Kelly of Denton, MD and Timothy R. Schlesner and his wife Kathleen of Denton, MD; 4 grandchildren who knew him as "Opa", William Schlesner, Nicholas Schlesner, Timothy Schlesner, Jr and Kaitlyn Schlesner; and brother-in-law, Walter Jung of Ohio.

He is predeceased by his sister, Gertrude Jung.
