



Rufus Philip Towers

January 26, 1922 - December 20, 2008

Rufus Philip Towers of Easton went home to be with his Lord and Savior from Genesis Health Care, the Pines, Easton, on Saturday, December 20, 2008. He was 86.

Born on January 26, 1922 in Easton, he was the son of the late, Robert N. and Laura King Towers. He attended Talbot County public schools. On March 30, 1947 he married the former, Beulah Mullikin, and they made their home in Easton. Mr. Towers worked at the Easton Hardware Co. for over 35 years retiring as Vice President in 1995.

Mr. Towers was a member of the Easton Church of God, where he taught Sunday School for many years, he served as a member of the Church Board, and was known for his willingness to always help wherever he was needed. He was also a member of T.O.P.S. for many years. In 1995 Mr. Towers won the statewide Delmarva Senior Adult Talent for his harmonica playing.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by a daughter, Donna L. Sard and her husband, Woodrow, of Easton; a brother, Nathaniel K. Towers and his wife, Joyce of Easton; three grandchildren, Kelsey R. Martinez and her husband, Pito, Kory N. Sard and his wife, Crystal and Kari M. Sard; numerous nieces and nephews and two great-grandsons on the way! In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by a daughter, Bonita L. Towers, and three sisters.
