Rumsey L. Seymour, a former President of the Trappe Town Council, died at his home in Trappe on Wednesday, Oct. 10, 2001. He was 61.

Born in Easton, February 2, 1940, he was the son of the late William Samuel and Louise Barnes Seymour. After graduating from Easton High School in 1958, he worked for A. E Seymour, Builders, in Easton, until 1966 when he went into business for himself by forming a business known as Rumsey Seymour, Contractors. He remained active in this business until retiring in January of 2000 for health reasons.

A resident of Trappe since 1960, he had been a member of the Trappe Vol. Fire Company for 37 years.

Mr. Seymour is survived by his wife, the former Gretchen Thomas whom he married on March 6, 1964; a daughter, Jill S. Christopher, of Trappe; two sons, Rumsey L. Seymour, Jr. and James O. Seymour, both of Trappe; a sister, Donna June Trout, of Salisbury; two brothers, Albert F. Seymour, of Forest Hills and William S. Seymour, Jr. of Chester and three grandchildren, Ashley Christopher, Caley Christopher and Emily Christopher.

Funeral services will be held on Sunday, October 14th, at 2 p.m. at the Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Easton, where friends

may call one hour prior to service.

Burial will be at the Whitemarsh Cemetery, Trappe.
