Russell Richard Klages of Easton, MD died on May 2nd, 2025. He was 88 years old.

Born on December 16, 1936, in Baltimore, MD, he was the son of the late Russell K. and Marie T. Langrher Klages. Mr. Klages graduated from Baltimore Polytechnic Institute in 1956. In September of the same year, he married the former Dorothy Mary Lippert. Mr. Klages worked for Baltimore City in the Plans and Computations Department until 1980, when he moved to the State of Maryland as a utility inspections worker. In 1964, the Klages moved to Queen Anne's County, and he worked part time as a land surveyor, eventually becoming a full-time employee in 1967. Mr. Klages owned and operated Russell Klages Surveying Services.

He was a member of the Kent Island Yacht Club, the Bay Country Moose, Easton Elks Lodge 1622, and the Kent Island Carvers, and always enjoyed carving waterfowl and birds.

He is survived by his children: Robyn Ann Smith of Mechanicsville, MD, David Brian Klages of Dallas, TX, and Richard Glenn Klages of Easton, MD; three grandchildren: William Russell Klages of Greensboro, MD, Bryan Edwards Klages of Ridgely, MD, and Michael Alexandra Smith of Mechanicsville; and three great-grandchildren: Hayden Allen Noha Klages, Shala Grace Klages,

and Riley A. Smith.

He was preceded in death by a brother, Ronald Glenn Klages of Fallston, MD.

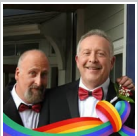

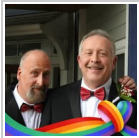
