



Russell Gene Taylor

October 21, 1938 - June 14, 2012

Russell "Van" Gene Taylor of Easton, MD, passed away at Easton Memorial Hospital on Thursday June 14, 2012, after a brief battle with lung cancer. He was 73.

Van was born October 21, 1938, in Salisbury to the late, Norris and Elizabeth Abbott Taylor. He was born and raised in Deal Island, MD, and graduated from Deal Island High School. He was a member of the Easton Moose Lodge 1520, and an active player in the APA Pool League.

He was a hard working waterman, a diesel mechanic for C.J. Langenfelder, and a caretaker for Robert Pascal until his health failed him in 1999. He loved spending time with his family and making people laugh.

He is survived by his wife of 45 years, Robin; his children, Cory Taylor (Melissa) of Preston; Greg Price Jr. (Kim) of Easton; Rusty Taylor Jr. (Ginny) of Salisbury; and Ricky Taylor (Lisa) of Crisfield; grandchildren, Cory Jr. (Skye), Zach (Kelsey), Greg III, Amanda, Ryan, Rusty III, Travis, Amy, Nikki, Jesse, Jenna; five great-grandchildren; his sister, Anna of Princess Anne; and a large extended family.

In addition to his parents, Van was preceded in death by his four siblings, Bobby, Dean, Helen, Julia; and a granddaughter, Tiffany Price.

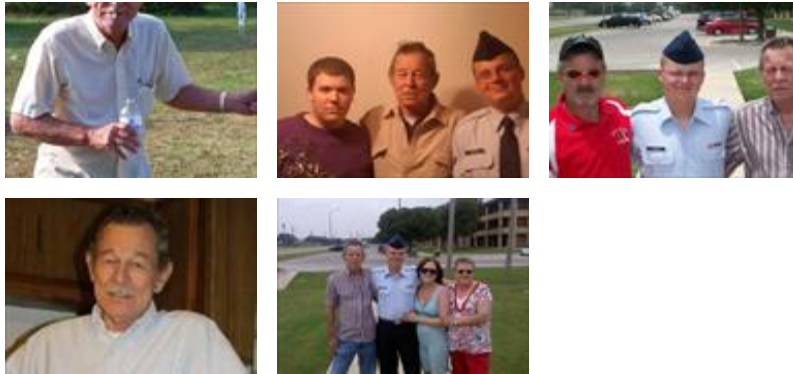
