



## Ruth A. Daffin

August 26, 1919 - September 9, 2010

Ruth Russell Daffin, 91, of Tunis Mills died Thursday, September 9, 2010, at Memorial Hospital in Easton. Born in Oxford, she was the daughter of the late John Russell and Almira Ellison Russell. Mrs. Daffin was a graduate of Easton High School and a member of All Saints Episcopal Church in Tunis Mills.

She worked as a checker for many years at the former A&P supermarket in Easton, where she made dozens of friends and was well-known for her outgoing personality and sense of humor. Following her retirement from the A&P, she was an avid homemaker, which had always been her passion.
