



## Ruth Naomi Covey

December 5, 1922 - November 29, 2019

Ruth Covey of Royal Oak, MD, died Friday, November 29, 2019, at Chesapeake Woods Center in Cambridge. She was 96 years old.

Born in Talbot County on December 5, 1922, she was the daughter of the late Bessie and George Jump. After graduating from St. Michaels High School in 1941, she worked for several years for the C&P Telephone Company in Easton. In recent years, she was a bookkeeper for her husband's business and her sons, Ronald Covey Masonry. She was a crafty lady, did beautiful crewel pictures for her home, and many other beautiful crafts. She loved the outdoors, her flowers and birds. She was a member of St. Luke's Methodist Church in St. Michaels. 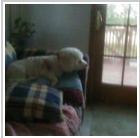
