Ruth Elizabeth Taylor of Church Hill, MD. died at her home on Monday, June 14, 2004. She was 85.

Born April 18, 1919, in Willoughby, MD, she was the daughter of the late John Jeffrey Mulligan Skinner and Susan Ethel Benson Skinner. She graduated from Tri-County High School in Queen Anne, MD, in 1936. On November 21, 1936, she married Joseph George Taylor, Sr. or Price, MD, and they began their life together on Cherry Blossom Farm that would last the rest of their lives. Happiest when she was with her husband, she and Joe worked together on their farm and enjoyed traveling with friends. Joseph Taylor, Sr. preceded her in death in 1995.

She was an active member of Price Bethany United Methodist Church where, among other roles, she was former President of United Methodist Women. She took pride in her home and her family. She was known locally for making her wonderful apple dumplings and white potato pies which were always popular at community bake sales.
