November 9, 1918 - April 2, 2008

Ruth E. Hayes of Easton, MD, died on Wednesday, April 2, 2008, at Talbot Hospice House in Easton. She was 89.

Born November 9, 1918, in Baltimore, MD, she was the daughter of the late Creston and Ruth Ensor Jackson. After graduation from Western High School in Baltimore, she attended McQueen Gibbs School of Nursing in Easton. During her career as a medical office manager, she worked for Drs. Cox, Kinnamon, Trevor, Carney and Fauntleroy until retiring in the late 1970's.

Her husband, Louis E. Hayes, Jr., whom she married in 1942, died in 1997.

She was a member of the Daughters of The American Revolution. She loved to read, work crossword puzzles, discuss politics, and going to the Ocean.

Mrs. Hayes is survived by her daughter, Carole L. Kilmon of Easton; two sons, Louis E. Hayes III of Ridgely and Durrie A. Hayes of Easton; and five grandchildren. She was predeceased by a daughter, Shirley Heineman, who died in 1997; one brother; and two sisters.
