Ruth L. Horn of Easton, MD, passed away at the University of Maryland Medical Center on November 8, 2010. She was 81 years of age.

Born in Easton on June 23, 1929, she was the daughter of the late, John W. and Louise Gardner McCarty. After graduating from Easton High School in 1947, she was employed by the C & P Telephone Company as an operator. After eight years as an operator, she became a supply clerk, a position she held until retiring in 1982 with 34 ½ years of service. She was then associated with her husband in the operation of the family business, The Marine Mart.

A lifelong resident of the Easton area, she was a member of the First Baptist Church in Easton and The Telephone Pioneers. She enjoyed sewing as a hobby and also enjoyed working in her flower gardens.

Her husband, Victor M. Horn, whom she married June 24, 1949, passed away on January 19, 2003.

Mrs. Horn is survived by a daughter, Peggy L. Mende of Hillsboro; a son, Irvin M. Horn of Federalsburg; two sisters, Blanche L. Fluharty of Dover, DE, and Vera Anthony of Smyrna, DE; three brothers, James L.
