



Ruth Lichtenberger

July 17, 1923 - April 10, 2020

Ruth Lichtenberger of Chestertown, MD, passed away on Friday, April 10, 2020, at University of Maryland Shore Medical Center at Chestertown. She was 96.

Born in Delaware County, PA, in 1923, she was the daughter of the late Paul and Elizabeth Letherbury. She is survived by her son, Mark, and his wife, Janine, of Salisbury, MD; and a grandson, John Armitage of Weehawken, NJ.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Les Lichtenberger; their daughter, Jan L. Armitage; and a sister, Virginia L. Noah.

She married Lester Lichtenberger in 1945. She and her husband moved to Newark, DE, in 1948 and later to Bridgeville, DE. They came with their family to Kent County, MD in 1961. She was a member of Emmanuel Episcopal Church, All Seasons Garden Club, and had been a volunteer with the American Cancer Society, Kent and Queen Anne's Hospital, Emmanuel Church, Red Cross, and Kent County Girl Scouts.

Interment will be held privately in St. Paul's Church Cemetery.
