Ruth Ernestine Phillips, of Worton, MD passed away on Tuesday, February 13, 2024, at the Chester River Hospital Center, with her daughter at her bedside, after a short illness. She was born on September 14, 1927, to the late George W. and Cora Mae Warner of Sandy Bottom, Chestertown, MD.

After graduating from Garnett High School, she moved to Philadelphia, PA to live with her Uncle Eddie and Aunt Nora Warner. While there, she attended school and was employed by Dr. Beauchamp, and his wife, as a nanny for their children. 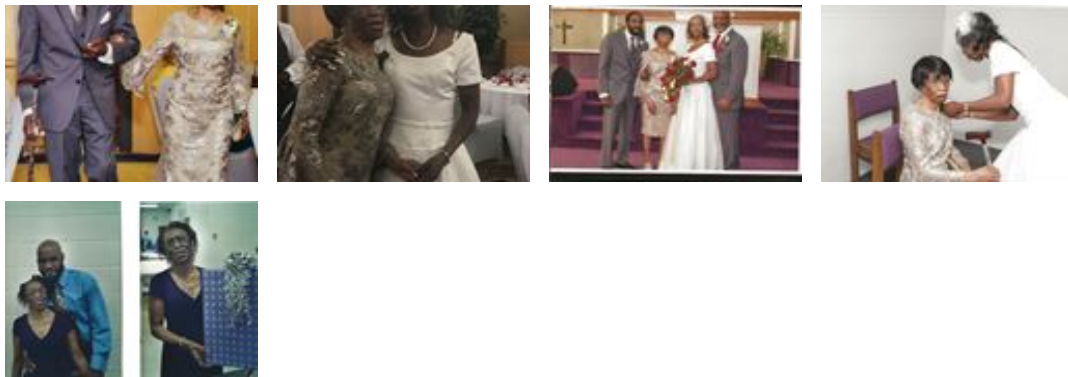
