October 1, 1914 - May 21, 2011

Ruth Violetta Clough of Church Hill, MD, died Saturday, May 21, 2011, at the Chester River Hospital Center in Chestertown, MD. She was 96.

Ruth V. Clough was born in Price, MD, the daughter of the late Joseph Bradford Taylor and Sarah "Cole" Taylor. Mrs. Clough was a lifetime resident of Queen Anne's County and in 1951, went to work for the U.S. Postal service and worked as Post Master in Price until retiring in 1974. She married her late husband, Casper D. Clough, in 1932. After working, she spent most of her life as a homemaker. She was a member of Bethany United Methodist Church in Price, MD. Her interests included going out to dinner with her family and friends, and being involved with her church where she used to teach Sunday school for several years.

In addition to her parents and husband, she was preceded in death by one daughter, Sarah Eloise Clough; one son, Robert T. Clough; one brother, Joseph Taylor Sr.; two sisters, Elizabeth Sparks, and Ethel Mae VonKleeck; and one granddaughter, Robin M. Clough.

She is survived by three sons, Charles Clough of Annapolis, MD, David G. Clough of White Sulphur Springs, NY, William A. Clough Sr., of Sudlersville, MD; one daughter, Doris Chandler of Ithica, NY; nine grandchildren; and numerous great-grandchildren; a sister-in-law, Helen Clough of Price, MD;
