Ruth Ellen Yewell of Greensboro, Maryland, passed away peacefully on October 9, 2025, at the age of 87.

Born on March 9, 1938, to Roland J. Taylor and Mary C. (née Trice) Taylor, Ruth was raised on Maryland's Eastern Shore. She graduated from Greensboro High School in 1956. She was one of three siblings, predeceased by her brother Theodore Taylor, and survived by her sister Ann Defond.

Ruth is lovingly remembered by her daughters, Tamre L.
