Sallie Mae Murphy, 94, of Easton, MD, passed away on Friday, November 16, 2018, at Genesis at The Pines in Easton where she had resided for three years. Sallie was born in Cordova, MD, on January 8, 1924, daughter of the late William T. Harris and Sally Parks Harris.
