



Salvatore Stefano

January 21, 1927 - October 9, 2013

Salvatore Stefano of Brookfield, CT, formerly of Easton, MD, passed away peacefully surrounded by family, on Wednesday, October 9, 2013, at Danbury Hospital in Danbury, CT. He was 86 years old.

Born in Montalbano Elicona, Sicily, Italy, on January 21, 1927, he was the son of the late Gaetano and Gaetana Stefano. After completing his education, Salvatore became the owner of a cafe /bar in Italy. He married his childhood sweetheart, Pauline, in 1957 in Tindari, Italy. In 1960, Salvatore and his wife moved to Easton where they owned and operated Stefano's Sub Shop on Route 50 for over 30 years. Salvatore was an excellent cook. He was also an avid antique collector and loved to paint. He loved opera and enjoyed watching soccer and boxing on TV.

Salvatore was preceded in death by his wife of 45 years, Pauline. He is survived by a daughter, Antonella Carlo and husband Jim, of Brookfield, CT; a son, Tommy Stefano and wife Nancy, of Easton; two grandchildren, Arianna Carlo and Paula Stefano; and one great-grandchild, Chace Stefano.
