Samuel Bell, Jr. died on Wednesday, November 25, 2009 at his home of 20 years, surrounded by his family, after a long illness.

Born May 25, 1924 in Chestnut Hill, PA, he was the son of the late Samuel and Isabel Frazer Bell. He graduated from St. Paul's School in Concord, NH and Princeton University and later served in the US Navy from 1943-1945. After working for The Miami Herald, he started his own advertising agency, Bell & Saunders, Inc. in Coral Gables, FL.

An avid yachtsman, he spent many years sailing with his wife, Anne on his beloved sailboat, Blue Angel. He was also a longstanding member of the Cruising Club of America.

In addition to his wife of 61 years, Anne, he is survived by three sons, Samuel Bell, III, Charles L. Bell, Nicholas S. Bell; a daughter, Tiffany Bell; a son-in-law, Richard Gluckman and two granddaughters, Nell Gluckman and Marina Gluckman.
