



Samuel Davis Hendrickson

February 25, 1924 - December 8, 2013

Samuel Davis Hendrickson of Still Pond passed away peacefully on December 8, 2013, at Chester River Manor. He was 89.

Born on February 25, 1924, he was the son of the late Harry Davis and Jessie Crew Hendrickson. He was raised on the family farm in Still Pond, where he continued to live on his part of the farm until his death. On March 31, 1945, he married Margaret Newcomb from Galena. He was a dairy and grain farmer and hunting guide, retiring in 1989. In later years, he was the manager for Bloomfield Farms near Kennedyville and was the caretaker for Royal Swan Farm in Still Pond until 2011.

Mr. Hendrickson was a member of Still Pond United Methodist Church, serving as trustee and usher. He was a member of the Maryland Farm Bureau, former member of Betterton Volunteer Fire Company, and a member of the Maryland Fur Trappers Association, from which he received several awards, including trapper of the year in 1988. He was an avid outdoorsman, enjoying crabbing, trapping, hunting ducks, geese, and deer and was fond of his yellow labs. He loved working in his garden, especially growing tomatoes for his friends.

Mr. Hendrickson is survived by his wife, Margaret of 68 years; his daughter, Louise Stonesifer and her husband, Ken of Chestertown, MD; two grandsons,

David W. Stonesifer and wife Rosanna of Mohnton, PA, and Kevin M. Stonesifer and wife Marguerite of Herndon, VA; a brother, Harry C. Hendrickson of Catonsville, MD, several nieces and nephews, and long-time devoted friend--William and Jamie Dempsey.

Services will be held on Wednesday, December 11, 2013 at 11:00 a.m. at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, Chestertown, MD, where relatives and friends may call one hour prior (10-11 a.m.)

Interment will be in Still Pond Cemetery following the service.
