Samuel Lodge McSorley, III, 75, a resident of Chestertown, Maryland since 1975, died September 27, 2001 in Easton Memorial Hospital, Easton, MD.

Born in Evanston, Illinois, he was the son of the late Samuel Lodge McSorley Jr. and Anne Rosalinda Copley.

Following graduation from Lake Forest Academy, he served as a Private First Class in the U.S. Army Air Corps, and graduated from Princeton University with a B.A. in 1950.

Mr. McSorley was a member of Old Saint Paul's Church of Kent County where he had served on the Vestry.

Formerly of Wilmington, Delaware and Wayne, Pennsylvania, Mr. McSorley was a member of the Optimist Club where he was instrumental in starting a YMCA. He was a past member of Chestertown Rotary International, honorary member of the Society of Gas Operators, honorary member of the Gas Lighters Club of New York, and a member of the Princeton Club of New York. He was a member of the Tolchester Community Association and a member of the American Legion in Chestertown. Mr. McSorley enjoyed the out of doors, hunting, boating and gardening, but most of all he enjoyed being with family and friends.

Mr. McSorley is survived by his wife of 53 years, Dorothea Mendinhall McSorley and three children, Ruth Anne Taylor of Fairfield, Connecticut, Nancy Hoffman of Carbondale, Colorado, and Samuel Edward McSorley of Chestertown. He had eight grandchildren.

A memorial service was held at 11AM, October 2, 2001 at Old St. Paul's Episcopal Church of Kent County outside Chestertown on Sandy Bottom Rd.
