



## Samuel Price

Samuel T. Price of Chestertown, MD died on Sunday, March 17, 2002 at Chestertown Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Chestertown, MD. He was 86.

Born on October 13, 1915 at Fort Benjamin Harrison, Indiana he was the son of the late Samuel Aldrich and Cornelia Tompkins Price. Mr. Price was a 1939 graduate of the University of South Carolina with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Geology. He was employed by the University of Georgia as an archaeologist and later with E.I. DuPont in explosives. He worked for some time at Carney's Point, N.J., Indiana, and Oklahoma in supervisory positions. Mr. Price transferred to Textile Fibers in Seaford, DE in 1943 and to DuPont Sales in Wilmington, DE in 1947 where he had a variety of managerial posts including 2 years in sales in Geneva, Switzerland. He retired in 1971 from DuPont. In 1972 he joined Enterprise Machine and Development Corporation and served as President until retiring in 1985.

He was a Life member of The Netherlands Society of Philadelphia, the N.R.A., and the University of South Carolina Alumni. He was also a member of Chester River Yacht and Country Club, Chestertown Hospital Auxiliary, where he served as Vice President, Emmanuel Episcopal Church, where he served on the Vestry and as Junior Warden, and a member of the 1782 club of Washington College. Mr. Price was an avid tennis player.

In addition to his wife, Eleanor Constance Wallace whom he married in 1941, he is survived by three children, Samuel Aldrich Price of Middletown, DE, James Wallace Price of Greeley, CO, and Harriet Price Silcox of Kennedyville, MD, and seven grandchildren.

Memorial services will be held on Sunday, March 24, 2002 at 4:00 P.M. at Emmanuel Episcopal Church in Chestertown, MD.
