



Samuel Hambleton "Bobo" Tennant

February 25, 1927 - June 17, 2008

Samuel Hambleton "Bobo" Tennant of Newcomb, MD passed away peacefully on Tuesday, June 17, 2008 at Talbot Hospice House, Easton, MD. He was 81.

Born February 25, 1927 in Wittman, MD, he was the son of the late Samuel H. and Anna Lee Denny Tennant. After attending public schools in Royal Oak and St. Michaels, he joined the U.S. Navy. Following his honorable discharge in 1946, he began a lifelong career as a waterman. He dearly loved the water and enjoyed fishing and crabbing. In his younger years he was an avid goose and duck hunter. He had a love of animals and nature and in later years enjoyed taking pictures rather than hunting. He also had a love of old Army jeeps and could often be seen riding around Newcomb in an old jeep, preferably with one of his dogs in the passenger seat.

In 1979 he married the love of his life, Margaret, and they began their life together in Newcomb. In the early years of their marriage she accompanied him when he was crabbing on his new boat, "Charlie".

"Bobo" never met a stranger and was never at a loss for conversation. He was a charter member of the men's club at Wal-Mart.

In addition to his wife, "Bobo" is survived by a son, Don "Mutt" Meritt and his wife Joyce of Easton; a daughter, Denise Taylor and her husband Pat of

Newcomb; three grandchildren, Chris Handley of Severn, Brent Handley of Easton, and Lisa Taylor of Cinnaminson, NJ; a sister, Sophia Coblentz of Towson; and numerous nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by two sisters, Pauline Hudson and Margaret Bagwell; and a brother, William Tennant.

Funeral services will be held on Monday, June 23, 2008 at 2:00 PM at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Easton, MD where friends may call one hour prior to the service.
