Samuel J. Hanford of Stevensville, MD died Tuesday, April 20, 2004 at Anne Arundel Medical Center. He was 90.

Born in Washington, DC on October 6, 1913, he was the son of the late Henry G. Hanford and Nellie M. Pugh. He graduated from Western High School and worked for C & P Telephone in White House Communications. While working at C & P, he met his wife Hilda Josephine Gray and they were married July 22, 1949 and resided in Wheaton, MD until 1974 when they relocated to Stevensville. During retirement, he enjoyed working with metal, fabricating unusual tools and parts. Currently he was helping to restore the airplane in which with Anne Lindbergh was taught to fly. He also enjoyed reading, astronomy, auto racing, photography, animals and especially dachshunds. Sam was known as being very quick witted, current on affairs and the man with the five-minute opinion.
