Samuel Norris “Sam” Saulsbury of Easton, departed this life on January 10, 2005 at Easton Memorial Hospital. He was 75.

Born in Easton on April 14, 1929, “Sam” was the son of the late Milton C. Saulsbury and Loretta A. Elliott Saulsbury. He attended school in Easton. At the age of 18, Sam enlisted in the Maryland National Guard and then in 1952 entered the U.S. Army. Following his release from active duty in 1954, he worked at various places including the Memorial Hospital, Hallock Construction, Seymour Builders and The Standard Fusee Plant in Easton from where he retired in 1994.
