Sandra Ann Ealy of Rock Hall, MD, passed away on November 27, 2016, at MedStar Washington Hospital. She was 79.

Born on June 8, 1937, in Washington County, PA, she was the daughter of the late Hugh Ealy and her mother Mary Elizabeth Huffman Ealy and stepfather Woody Huffman. She graduated from Washington High School in Washington, PA, Class of 1955.

Sandy opened her own hoagie shop in Glassboro, NJ, while putting herself through Glassboro State College, where she graduated with a Bachelor of Science degree in 1987. During her time at Glassboro, she also continued her education during summer breaks at the Ecolo Hoteliere Lausanne in Switzerland and graduated in 1985. Sandy later attended Johnson and Wales, graduating in 1989 with a degree in Culinary Skills – Vo Tech teacher. In 1995, after teaching for many years, she moved to Rock Hall, MD, with her partner, Diane Carey. They accomplished what every Chef dreams of – owning their own restaurant, The Swan Point Inn, located in Rock Hall. Sandy loved teaching and shared her knowledge over the years with several people who wanted to learn the proper way to prepare food. Sandy and Diane married on January 14, 2014, and were partners, best friends, soul mates and the love of each other's lives.

Everyone who knew Sandy knew how kindhearted she was. She says goodbye to all of you and, of course, she did not want any fuss made on her behalf.
