



## Sandra K. Harvey

August 25, 1948 - October 28, 2011

Sandra K. Harvey of Rock Hall, MD, died on Friday October 28, 2011, in the Chester River Hospital Center, Chestertown, MD. She was 63.

Mrs. Harvey was born in Chestertown, MD. She was the daughter of the late Bobby Owen Clark, Sr., and Loretta Mae Kendall Clark of Rock Hall, MD.

She was a 1967 graduate of Rock Hall High School. Sandra worked for George Sutton and Peggy Parsons for 13 years as a hairdresser. She then worked as a Bank Teller and Customer Service Representative for the Peoples Bank in both Chestertown and Rock Hall for 14 years. In her later years, Mrs. Harvey enjoyed selling real estate part-time for Wyble Enterprises.

She was a member of the Rock Hall United Methodist Church, where she was active in the In Touch Ministry program. Sandra enjoyed attending activities at the Chestertown Elks Lodge as well as watching her grandsons' sporting events. She loved to shop and go out to dinner with her friends. The most important thing in her life was her family and her friends.

In addition to her father, she was preceded in death by her husband, Bobby G. Harvey in 2006.

In addition to her mother, she is survived by two daughters, Shelley Hillyer

and her husband, Ed, of Tolchester, MD, and Courtney Chipouras and her husband Steven of Middletown, DE; two grandsons, Myles and Ben Hillyer of Tolchester, MD; one brother, Bobby O. Clark, Jr., of Rock Hall, MD; and one sister, Oneida C. Jacquette, also of Rock Hall, MD.
