



## Sandra Lee Lane

April 23, 1944 - December 26, 2014

Sandra Lee Snyder Lane of Chestertown, MD, passed away on Friday, December 26, in Chestertown, MD, surrounded by her loving family and friends. She was 70 years young.

She was born April 23, 1944, in Lewisburg, PA, daughter of the late Glenn Delcamp Snyder and Betty June Lee Snyder. Mrs. Lane was raised in Milton, PA, and was a graduate of Milton High School, Class of 1962. Mrs. Lane later moved to Rockville, MD.

She married James L. Lane, Jr., on June 2, 1984, and they moved to Chestertown in March of 1995 where they raised two wonderful children together. Mrs. Lane spent most of her life as a homemaker taking care of her family. She was also a foster mother for eleven years and truly enjoyed taking care of the fifty-four children they had in their home.

She was an avid bowler and was actively involved in the bowling league. She served several years as the 1st Vice-President and then became President of the Chesapeake Bay Women's Bowling Association. She also served as a member of the Maryland State Women's Board. She was instrumental in merging the local bowling associations to form the Greater Chesapeake USBC Association and served as their first President. She was a member of the "Misfits" and "Misfits II" bowling teams for many years.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her sisters, Francis Snyder Branch and Gloria Snyder Young.

Mrs. Lane is survived by her husband of 30 years, James Lane of Chestertown; son, Brian Lane of Chestertown, and daughter, Katherine Lane of Chestertown; sister Susan Reich of Milton, PA; and brother Glenn Snyder of Milton, PA.

A viewing will be held on Saturday, January 10, 2014, from 11 am to 1 pm at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newman Funeral Home, 130 Speer Road, Chestertown, MD.

Graveside services and internment will be held at noon, January 17, at the Mazeppa Union Cemetery, Lewisburg, PA. Services will be performed by Father Hoke.

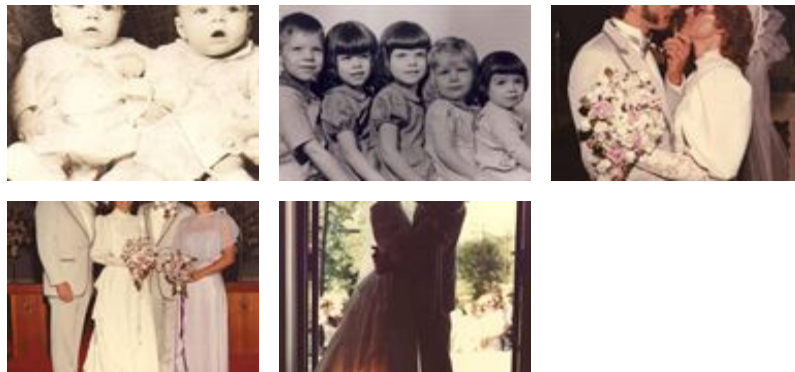
