A Memorial Mass for Sara B. Johnston will be celebrated at St. Joseph's Mission Church in Cordova, MD, on Friday, January 3, 2014, at 10 a.m.

Mrs. Johnston of Wye Mills, MD, died on Monday, December 30, 2013, at UMSMC in Easton. She was 71. Born in Warrenton, VA, on February 8, 1942, she was the daughter of the late G. Leslie and Mabel Kirby Grimes.

After graduating from Franklin High School in Reisterstown, she worked for 30 years as the Executive Secretary for the Vice President of Northrop-Grumman at Thurgood Marshall BWI, retiring in 2004. She moved from Baltimore County to Wye Mills in 1998, and was a member of St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Cordova. Devoted to her pets, she was also an enthusiastic Baltimore Ravens fan.
