Sara Louise Price, of Trappe, MD, died at Memorial Hospital at Easton on June 19, 2012. She was 91.

Born in Sudlersville, MD, on September 19, 1920, she was the daughter of the late William Dudley and Maggie Lafferty Moore. After graduating from Millington High School, she worked as a waitress in Smyrna, DE, and Betterton, MD. In February of 1945, she married Thurman D. Price, a member of the U.S. Army.

Following his release from active duty, they moved to Trappe, MD, where she assisted him in the operation of a local service station until its closing in 1978. She then worked for years as an Avon Lady.

Mrs. Price is survived by a sister and brother, M. Virginia Kennedy and Joseph B. Moore, both of Florida. She is predeceased by two sisters, Margaret C. Dulin and Pauline M. Farran.

A graveside service and burial will be held at the Maryland Eastern Shore Veterans Cemetery Chapel on Thursday, June 28 at 1 p.m.
