April 3, 1925 - June 13, 2022

Sara E. Towers, 97, of Easton formerly of Centreville, went home to be with the Lord, and her family on June 13, 2022.

She was born on April 3, 1925, the daughter of the late Ralph Lee and Sara Stevens Whaley at Prospect Bay Farm, Grasonville MD. They sold the farm at Prospect Bay to purchase the Cedardale Farm on Bloomingdale RD, Queenstown, MD.

Sara was a 1942 graduate of Centreville High School and a 1946 graduate of Washington College in Chestertown, MD. She met and married her husband, Robert K. Towers, after that they had gone to school together but did not meet until a blind date. She began her teaching career in Baltimore Co., then was hired by Dr. Harry Rhodes to teach in Queen Anne's County, retiring in the mid 1980s. They made their home and raised their family at Centreville Heights.

She enjoyed reading about the history of England, studying genealogy, researching her and her husband's lineage. Sara also enjoyed traveling throughout the US, Scotland, England, and Ireland.

She was a member of Daughters of American Revolution, Perry Benson Chapter, Daughters of the War of 1812; her local Retired Teachers Association; and the Centreville High School Alumni Association.

In recent years she lived in Easton at Bayleigh Chase Assisted Living where the staff became another part of extended family.

Sara is predeceased in death by her husband, Robert K. Towers, her pare Ralph Lee and Sara Stevens Whaley, Siblings Mary Ethel Comegys, John Lee Whaley and Ralph Carvel Whaley.

She is survived by her children: James Carvel (Diane) Towers, Robert C. (Debbie) Towers, Jennifer A. (Mark) Winters; her sister Constance (Donald) Fassett; her granddchildren; Elizabeth Marie Towers, Andrew C. Towers, Sara A. Maynard, Megan RM Towers; and her great-grandchildren; Juliann Towers and Jackson Maynard.
