



## Sara Foard Bauzenberger

March 11, 1917 - May 16, 2010

Sara Foard Bauzenberger of Easton died peacefully with her family at her side on Sunday, May 16th, 2010, in her home, The Gardens at the William Hill Manor. She was 93 years old.

Born in Haddonfield, New Jersey on March 11, 1917, she was the daughter of Malcolm B. and Sara L. Foard. She attended the Baldwin School, a private school for girls, in Bryn Mawr, PA. She and her husband, William Bauzenberger, were married in Radnor, Pa on February 3, 1939. After several years living in Pittsburgh, they returned to Philadelphia. They also lived in Wayne, Pennsylvania and Stone Harbor, New Jersey during this time. After the retirement of her husband, they moved permanently to the Miles River area in Talbot County, Maryland.

Her greatest enjoyment in life was her family. She was active in church work and Youth Fellowship. Her hobbies included artwork, knitting, gardening and flower arrangement. She also was very keen at the bridge table. She was an avid boater with her husband. They had been members of the Navy League, U.S. Sail & Power Squadron, U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary, Poplar Islands Yacht Club, Edge Creek Boat Club, Stone Harbor Yacht Club, T-4 C's and Miles River Yacht Club.

She is survived by her daughter and son-in-law, Connie and Bud Wallace of

Oxford, MD. ,her son and daughter-in-law, Craig and Ande Bauzenberger of Marlton, N.J., three grandchildren, Cathy Dowd and husband Bill of Easton, MD., Michele Rue and her husband Jerry of Ashburn, Va., and Craig Bauzenberger, Jr. of Marlton, N.J.. Eight great grandchildren also survive Mrs. Bauzenberger. Mrs. Bauzenberger was pre-deceased by her husband of 67 years, William B. Bauzenberger, her father, Malcolm Bayard Foard, her mother, Sara Leemaster Stager, and her brother, John Stager Foard.

A memorial service will be held on May 21st, 2010 at 10:00 AM at Christ Episcopal Church in Easton, Md.

Interment will be private at a later date in Old Drawyers Cemetery in Odessa, Delaware.
