



Sarah Catherine Caulk

March 5, 1927 - August 10, 2015

Sarah Catherine (Freeman/Waters) Caulk of Chestertown, MD, went home to be with the Lord and her savior Jesus Christ on Monday, August 10, 2015, at Christiana Care Hospital in Newark, DE.

She was raised from the age of two to adulthood by the late Harry and Susie Waters of Melitota, MD. Mrs. Caulk accepted Jesus Christ as her Savior at an early age at Mount Pisgah United Methodist Church, Melitota, where she remained a faithful member and was the eldest member of the church at the time of her passing.

She attended Garnett High School, Class of 1944, and, upon graduation, she worked as a homemaker and caregiver. In 1962, she began working for the Campbell Soup Company as a line worker. After working for the Campbell Soup Company for 25 years, she retired and resumed her role as a caregiver for children and the elderly for a few local families. Later, she would serve as a foster grandparent for the J. DeWeese Carter Children's Center where she provided mentoring, nurturing, love, and support to troubled youth for over eight years.

Over her years of service to the church, she served in numerous roles to include secretary, treasurer, communion steward, trustee board member, and administrative chair. Mrs. Caulk was also a dedicated member of the Rosebud

Court of Calanthe NO. 36 and the Elks Lodge Star Temple #1141.

Her interests included traveling, cooking, reading, serving the church, and spending quality time with family and friends.

Mrs. Caulk was united in marriage to the late John E. Caulk, Sr. in 1953.

Mrs. Caulk leaves her two daughters, Carol Y. Camper and husband Jerome of Newark, DE, and Jennifer O. Christy and husband Allen of Chestertown, MD; four sons, Lord B.
