



Sarah Elizabeth Doyle

August 30, 1945 - August 3, 2013

Sarah E. Doyle of Preston, MD, died on August 3, 2013, after a long fought illness deriving from cancer. She was 67.

Born August 30, 1945, in Newark, NJ, she was the daughter of the late John and Nadine King Skelton. She graduated from Wicomico High School in Salisbury, MD., and worked for Preston Trucking for 20 years.

In her spare time she was active in the Cub Scouts, where she was a den leader coach/trainer for Delmarva Council. For all her involvement, she received the highest honor, the National Silver Beaver Award.

She was a member of Saints Peter and Paul Catholic Church since 1967, where she served as a Eucharistic Minister and taught Sunday school. She was also past President of the Ladies Auxiliary of Preston Volunteer Fire Department.

Mrs. Doyle is survived by her husband, Kenneth Doyle whom she married April 18, 1963, and they just celebrated 50 years; three sons, Patrick Doyle (Rhonda) of East New Market, Sean Doyle (Melissa), of Queenstown, MD, and Brian Doyle (Karen), of Easton, MD; eleven grandchildren, James, Jonathan, Victoria, Benjamin, Zane, Emily, Christopher, Matthew, Joseph, Samatha, and Edward; sisters, Nadine Renshaw of Pocomoke City, MD, and

She was predeceased by a brother, John Skelton, and a sister, Christine Skelton.
