October 29, 1944 - January 5, 2021

Sarah Ann Duncan of Arlington, VA passed away on January 5, 2021 at The Virginian Retirement Community. She was 76.

Born on October 29, 1944 in Easton, MD, she was the daughter of the late Walter H. Barnes and Edith Virginia (Wright) Barnes. Sarah "Sally" grew up in Easton and graduated from Easton High School. Sally went to the University of Maryland and then returned to Easton to raise her family. She worked as an office manager for 30 years. She retired in 2003 and in 2013 moved to Virginia to be closer to family.
