Sarah Jane Stant of Chestertown, MD, died on September 26, 2005, at Chestertown Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Chestertown, MD. She was 82.

Born on July 25, 1923, near Centreville, MD, she was the daughter of the late John Clayton Chambers and Della Plummer Richardson. Mrs. Stant was a 1940 graduate of Chestertown High School and on July 12, 1941, she married William Howard Stant. They resided on the family's farm in Price, MD, and Mrs. Stant worked with Cal Merriken Fertilizer Company as a secretary and bookkeeper for 10 years. She then worked in the same capacity with Eastern Shore Pre Release Unit until 1989 when she retired. She and her husband moved to Chestertown, MD, in 1981. Her husband predeceased her on August 12, 1996.

Mrs. Stant and her husband raised, owned, and trained harness racing horses. She also enjoyed floral gardening and playing cards. She was a member of Bethany United Methodist Church in Price and the Order of the Eastern Star #69.

She is survived by a sister, Margaret Newnam and her husband Bobby of Massey, MD; two nieces, Barbara Rice and her husband, Rich, of Edgewater, MD (and their children: Susan and Michael), and Beverly Horner and her husband, Bud, of Salisbury, MD (and their children Robbie and Julie); along with numerous cousins.

Funeral services will be held on Friday, September 30, 2005 at 11:00 A.M. at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, 130 Speer Road, in Chestertown where relatives and friends may visit on Thursday September 29, 2005, between the hours of 6:00 and 8:00 P.M.
