



## Sarah H. Mueller

September 8, 1961 - March 4, 2021

Sarah Harding Mueller (Browne) passed away on the morning of March 4, 2021. She was beloved by her family as a wife, mother, grandmother, stepmother, sister and daughter, as well as by many friends in several communities around the Eastern Shore.
