



## Sarah Lillian Smith

February 15, 1920 - June 14, 2016

Sarah Lillian “nee Jamar” Smith of Chestertown, MD, died on June 14, 2016, at the University of Maryland Shore Nursing & Rehab Center in Chestertown. She was 96.

Born in Morgnec, near Chestertown, on February 15, 1920, Sarah was the daughter of the late Reuben Franklin Jamar and Janie Louise Usilton Jamar. She attended school in Morgnec, Kent Co. She married Harry S. Whiteley in 1938 and resided in Betterton, MD.

She worked for Glen L. Martin in Chestertown in the 1940’s, the Sweitser’s Hosiery Mill on Cannon Street until the mid 50’s, and at Fishers Hosiery on Flatland Rd in Chestertown until 1961.

She and her second husband, Robert Allen Smith, moved to Cali, Columbia, and Amsterdam, Holland, returning to the US in 1976 and made their home in Pennsville, NJ. They later returned to Kentmore Park, where they owned and operated the Kentmore Park Store. Her last residence was in Queen Anne’s Co. in the area of Crouse’s Mill, Queen Anne, MD.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Robert A. Smith in August 2006; brothers, Reuben F. Jr., and Robert D. Jamar, Rock Hall, MD; sisters, M. Elizabeth Myers Betterton, Katherine “Kitty” M. Greenwood, Camden, DE,
