



Sarah Sutherland Stoner

December 26, 1931 - December 26, 2018

Sarah Sutherland Stoner, 87, died peacefully at her home in Easton, MD, on December 27, 2018.

She was born on December 26, 1931, in Atlanta, GA, to William (Bill) Anderson Sutherland and Sarah Hall Sutherland.

Sarah inherited her father's zest for life and lived it to the fullest. She attended the Lovett Country School in Atlanta, GA, and graduated high school from The Madeira School in 1949. She attended Bryn Mawr College for two years before marrying the love of her life, Frank Rahm Stoner, III, in 1951.

Sarah and Frank lived in Washington, DC, where she joined the Junior League and served as a volunteer for the prevention of blindness. She and Frank moved to Sewickley, PA, in 1956 where they raised their three children and lived happily for 36 years. Sarah became active in the Sewickley Presbyterian Church serving as an elder twice as well as serving on the board at the Sewickley Public Library, the Lockland Children's Center, and Friendship House. She was a member of the Child Health Association of Sewickley, the Village Garden Club and the Women's Association of the Presbyterian Church where she and co-chair, Mrs. William D. Roberts, published a cookbook called "Seasoned in Sewickley" in 1980.

In 1992, she and Frank moved to Easton, MD, and built their dream house on the water, Frank died of cancer in 1997.

Sarah spent the last 21 years enjoying her family and friends, bridge, photography and book clubs as well as volunteering at the Talbot County Free Library. She was a member of the Harbor Club, the Garden Club of the Eastern Shore, and the Talbot Country Club.

Sarah is survived by her three children, Sally Goswell, Jack Stoner, Frank Stoner, and eight grandchildren.

A memorial service will be held on Saturday, January 12, 2019, at 11 a.m. at St. Mark's United Methodist Church, 100 Peachblossom Rd., in Easton.

In lieu of flowers, memorial contributions may be made in her honor to St. Marks United Methodist Church; and the Talbot County Free Library.
