Sarah H. Crockett, of York, PA, formerly of Oxford, MD died on Tuesday, December 9, 2003 at the Country Meadows Retirement Community in York where she had resided for the last five years. She was 88.

Born in Sherwood, MD, January 9, 1915, she was the daughter of the late Arthur Langton and Carrie Alberta Wrightson Harrison. After graduating from St. Michaels High School, she attended St. Mary's College of Maryland and the Strayer Business College. She then worked in the office of the Register of Wills for Talbot County until her marriage in 1942 to Arthur S. Crockett, Sr. They made their home in Oxford where she was a member and, for 25 years, the Treasurer of the Oxford United Methodist Church. She also was a volunteer at the Oxford Library. She worked for several years as a Registrar at the Emergency Room at Memorial Hospital at Easton.

Mr. Crockett died April 27, 1975.

Mrs. Crockett is survived by a son, A. Scott Crockett, Jr. and his wife, Shirley, of Jarrettsville, MD and two grandsons, Michael B. Crockett and Jonathan S. Crockett. Two brothers, Louis A. Harrison and Philemon T. Harrison, are deceased.

Oxford United Methodist Church, Oxford.

Private burial will be at the Oxford Cemetery, Oxford, MD.
