



## Sara Hundley Bartlett

November 24, 1924 - April 21, 2009

Sara (Sally) Hundley Bartlett, of Easton died on April 21, 2009. She was 84. Born in Baltimore on November 24, 1924, she was the only daughter of the late Arthur F. and Jane T. Hundley. Sally was educated in schools in Baltimore and was a graduate of Bryn Mawr College. After moving to Craig Point Farm in Trappe, Sally met and married Francis Gilpin Bartlett, Jr. on November 5, 1955. Mr. Bartlett died on January 12, 2005.

In 1960 Sally became the first director of Christ Church Day School and remained in that position until 1975.

Sally is survived by four nephews, Henry D. Lane of Fairfield, Connecticut, William L. Lane, Jr. of Easton, Maryland, Thomas D. Lane of Easton, Maryland and Francis B. Lane of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania; four nieces, Elizabeth B. Culp of Norman, Oklahoma, Amy B. Wright of Portsmouth, Rhode Island, Cynthia M. Bartlett of Easton, Maryland and Emily B. McQuillen of Easton, Maryland. She is also survived by eighteen great nephews and great nieces.

A memorial service will be held at Christ Church, Easton on Wednesday, April 29, 2009 at 1:00 PM and burial will be in Loudon Park Cemetery in Baltimore at the convenience of the family.
