Sara Marie Crispell of Millington, MD died Tuesday, September 13, 2011 at the University of Maryland Shock Trauma Center in Baltimore, MD following injuries sustained in a motor vehicle accident on August 16, 2011. She was 21.

Sara Marie Crispell was born June 7, 1990 in Silver Spring, MD, the daughter of Michele Rose Morgan and Duane French Crispell. Sara has lived in Forestville, MD, Denton, MD, and moved to Millington, MD ten years ago. She was a 2008 graduate of Queen Anne's County High school. She then attended Chesapeake College before receiving her Maryland Board of Nursing Certifications as a GNA and CNA through the Federal Job Corps Program. Sara worked as a Geriatric Nursing Assistant at Chester River Manor in Chestertown, MD where she was loved by all of her patients and co-workers. Sara was planning to continue her education and become a registered nurse.

She was preceded in death by her maternal grandparents, David and Rosemarie Castle.
