Sara Melissa "Lisa" Bishop of Chestertown, MD died on Saturday, May 15, 2010 at her home. She was 56.

Born on July 10, 1953 in Chestertown, MD she is the daughter of Harold Copper Williams, Jr. of Trappe, MD and Maxine Benson Larrimore of Chestertown, MD. She began her career with the Kent County Department of Social Services via CETA, a government subsidized training program. Mrs. Bishop started as a temporary typist clerk then earned a permanent job as a case manager; got promoted to Supervisor of Case Managers and Special Programs and lastly appointed Director of The Family Investment Administration. She retired in April of 2007 after 32 years as a state employee. While employed she earned an Associates in Arts degree from Chesapeake College, in 1989 and a Bachelor of Arts degree in 1994 from the College of Notre Dame of Maryland. After the sudden passing of her husband, John C. Bishop, Jr. in March of 2007 she moved to The Villages, Florida, where she was a full time resident until recently moving back to Chestertown.

Mrs. Bishop created mosaics and stained glass projects and enjoyed boating, fishing, crabbing, and a day at the beach. She also enjoyed traveling, dining out, bowling, shuffleboard and golf.

She is survived by her mother, Maxine Larrimore of Chestertown, MD; her

father, Harold C. Williams Jr. and his wife, Michele of Trappe, MD; two step sons, John "JB" Bronson Bishop of Goldsboro, MD and Cody Abram Bishop of Goldsboro, MD; a sister, Cynthia "Cindy" Williams of Chestertown, MD; her faithful companion, a bichon frise, Lola; and a dear devoted friend, Ray Glover of Chestertown, MD.

Services will be held on Friday, May 21, 2010 at 11:00 AM at the Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, 130 Speer Rd. Chestertown, MD where friends and family may call on Thursday, May 20 from 6:00 to 8:00 PM.
