



Sara Spies Garrett

January 29, 1928 - May 26, 2009

Sara Spies Garrett of Easton died on Tuesday, May 26, 2009 at the University of Maryland Medical Center in Baltimore. She was 81.

Born January 29, 1928 in Cordova, she was the daughter of the late, Henry Alfred and Mary Macklem Spies.

She was raised in Cordova on the family farm, "Square Farm". She graduated from Cordova High School in 1945 and was the class valedictorian. On February 14, 1946 she married James Alexander Garrett, Sr. During her years as a wife and mother, she was active with her husband in the farming and poultry industry and very involved within her community.

She was very family oriented and in her spare time loved cooking, gardening and canning.

Mr. Garrett died May 3, 1986.
