



Seymour Yanofski

October 10, 1920 - January 15, 2010

Seymour L. Yanofski died on Friday, January 15, 2010 at the Caroline County Hospice House. He was 89 years old.

Born in Waterbury, CT on October 16, 1920, he was the son of the late, Samuel and Alice Soloman Yanofski. He graduated from the Samuel Gompers Vocational School in the Bronx, NY and then worked in the Civilian Conservation Corps. Shortly after the bombing at Pearl Harbor, Mr. Yanofski then served his country in the Navy. He spent his career working for Con Edison in the Van Ness Shops in the Bronx as a supervisor for over 40 years. After his retirement, he moved to Wittman, where he volunteered at the St. Michaels Maritime Museum.

Seymour was a Mason for over 50 years and proudly wore his Masonic ring.

Prior to his illness, Mr. Yanofski enjoyed travelling with his wife of over thirty years, Shelia, who is a trained RN from England and was a devoted caregiver during his prolonged illness.

In addition to his wife, Mr. Yanofski leaves behind two children, Alice Yanofski Schiller (Leonard) of Stockbridge, MA, and Daniel Yanofski (Fern) of West Orange, NJ; four step-children, Christopher Arlott, Christine Arlott, Cathryn Arlott, and Charles Arlott; one brother, Norman Yanofsky (Shirley) of Deer

Park, NY; and five grandchildren, Ilana Schiller Pierro (Donald) of New Providence, NJ, Felicia Schiller Nevo (Moty) of Pittsfield, MA, Jason Yanofski, MD of New Haven, CT, Heather Yanofski Lowy (Jared) of Millburn, NJ, and Scott Yanofski. A school-days and loyal friend, Melvin, and his wife, Roberta, and their family will miss Seymour after spending years together at school, Civilian Conservation camps and the Navy together. Seymour was dearly loved, and will be missed by many relatives and friends in England.

Seymour Yanofski will be buried at 2:00 pm on Tuesday, January 19, 2010 at Oxford Cemetery in Oxford, MD. Family and friends will mourn at their homes.
